Dear Parents and Carers,

If you could talk through the following points with your child, as we have done in school, it will make a major difference and is good preparation for Secondary school.

Eat sensibly: Sugar can give you a rush of energy then a crash shortly afterwards. Remember to eat sensibly with plenty of fruit and vegetables.

During the test: Check your answers, really do check them! A proper check could make all the difference.
